

Not Today Satan Wk 4 Group Discussion Guide

1- Have someone tell the story of David & Goliath (1 Samuel 17) in their own words and read 1 Samuel 17:44-47. Why did both men say that the birds would eat the other man's flesh? Why was this such a terrible thought in the ancient world?

2- Like David, we all have a giant in our lives. Who or what is your giant today?

3- In Revelation 19, John sees a vision of God's justice & wrath. Jesus is on a white horse, riding with all of His faithful servants. Read Revelation 19:17-21. What thought or feeling is your initial response to this passage?

4- Read Revelation 19:17-18 & Ezekiel 39:17-20. What is the significance of the angel standing in the sun? What does this teach us about Jesus?

5- Remember the 2 beasts in Revelation 13? Read Revelation 13:1-14. Who/what does the first beast symbolize? Who/what does the 2nd beast symbolize?

6- Read Revelation 19:19 & Psalm 2:2. What are some ways that the first century Christians could relate to this verse? Where do you see hostility growing toward Christians today?

7- Read Revelation 19:20 & Revelation 13:11-12. How do these verses show the power & danger of deception? What makes deception so difficult to detect at times? When have you been deceived in your life?

8- In Revelation 19:20, the two beasts deceived earth dwellers into worshipping them (and the dragon) rather than the Lamb. Why do you think verse 20 is emphasizing that these beasts were “captured” and “thrown alive” into the lake of fire? (Seth talked

about one possibility by showing how Revelation 19 resembles a Roman Triumph)

9- What have you been told about the Battle of Armageddon? What are some ways that Revelation 19 supports or contradicts ideas you've been told?

10- Read Revelation 19:21 & Isaiah 11:4. What are some past, present & future ways that evil is destroyed from the "sword that came from the mouth of the rider on the horse"?

11- Read Revelation 19:17-21.

After walking through this passage, what do you sense that Christ wants you to take away from it?

12- Lift one another up in prayer & spend time thanking Jesus for being the King Who slays our giants.
