

## Group Discussion Guide

### Immeasurably More Week 5

1- On Sunday, we walked through Acts 2:42-47. Before we discuss this passage, have someone recap the story of the early Church up to this point.

2- Read Acts 2:42-47. What detail(s) do you notice the most in these verses?

3- What inspires you about Acts 2:42-47? What might a church like this look like today?

4- Read Acts 2:42. The disciples lived out 4 shared devotions together. Which of the shared devotions do you live out most consistently? Do you tend to include other believers in that devotion?

5- Read Acts 2:43 & Acts 9:31. What do you think it would be like to witness the apostles performing miracles? How did the miracles affect the early Church? Have you ever witnessed a miracle?

6- Read Acts 2:44-45. Imagine that you lived with this group of believers. What do you think it would be like? What obstacles must be overcome to experience life like this?

7- Have you experienced the joy of meeting a need in another Christian's life? Have you experienced the joy of having a need met by another believer? Share your stories.

8- Read Acts 2:46-47. These verses give us a glimpse of the every day lives of the Church in Jerusalem. What activities did they do together every day? What was some of the results from sharing their lives in Christ each day?

9- Seth talked about 2 major obstacles that we must overcome in order to experience the community that the early church enjoyed:

Fear

A limiting view of salvation: we can focus on what we're saved FROM while overlooking what we are also saved FOR.

Which of these obstacles do you need to overcome? How does that particular obstacle affect your life with other believers?

10- What are some practical steps that we can take in the life of our group that can help us experience a fuller life with Jesus & one another? Which step(s) will we commit to take together?

11- Spend time praying with each other. Rather than appointing 1 person to pray, encourage anyone who feels led to pray for each of the following points to do so. Read each point and pause in silence...allowing others to pray.

- Thank Jesus for saving us from our sins

- Thank Christ for saving us for life with one another

- Ask the Holy Spirit's to allow your group to experience life that that resembles the Church in Acts 2. Ask Him to provide His power, wisdom and discernment to overcome your fears & any other obstacles that stand in your way.
