

Not Today Satan Wk 3 Group Discussion Guide

1- What characteristics help build your trust or hinder your trust in others? What people have held your trust well in your life?

2- Let's recap the apostle John's season of life when he wrote the book of Revelation. What was life like for him then? What are some ways that you can relate with the apostle John's life?

3- Have someone read Revelation 19:11-16. Spend a few minutes praying together, asking Jesus to speak to you through this passage.

4- Read Revelation 19:11 & Revelation 1:5. What do these verses reveal about Jesus? How do you see this scene (Revelation 19:11) in your mind?

5- Read Revelation 19:12, Revelation 1:14 & Revelation 2:18. What are some ways that these verses shed light on one another? What is John emphasizing with Christ's eyes & crowns?

6- Revelation 19:12 says that Jesus "had a name written that no one knows except Himself." What do you think John is trying to communicate with this phrase?

7- Read Revelation 19:13. Why is Jesus wearing a robe dipped in blood rather than battle armor? How can Christ's bloody robe fill us with strength, encouragement & hope?

8- Revelation 19:13 also says that Christ is "called the Word of God." Read John 1:1-3 & John 1:14. What is the significance of Jesus being called the Word?

9- Read Revelation 19:14. Who is this army? What are the people in this army doing? Why are they wearing "pure white linen"?

10- Read Revelation 19:15, Psalm 2:9 & then read all of Psalm chapter 2. How do these passages relate with each other? What are they saying about Jesus?

11- Read Revelation 19:15 again. This verse is packed with symbolism. How might the first century Christians relate with this verse? What are some ways that this verse can connect to our lives today?

12- Read Revelation 19:16. Of all places to have these names written on Jesus...why would they be written on His robe & thigh?

13- Read Revelation 19:11-16 again. What is Jesus specifically communicating to you through this passage? What do you need to carry away from our discussion?

14- Close out your time by lifting one another up in prayer. Use the answers to the previous question (#13) to guide your prayers.
