

Reset Wk 4 Group Discussion Guide

1- On Sunday, we wrapped up our 39 week journey through the book of Revelation. The first 5 words of the book are key... "The revelation (revealing) of Jesus Christ". So one of the purposes of Revelation is to help us see Jesus more. What are some ways that our journey has helped you see Jesus more? Are there any additional ways that your life has been blessed by our journey?

2- Read Revelation 22:6-21. Which verses do you notice the most?

3- Read Revelation 22:6-7. In verse 6, the Apostle John is having a conversation with the angel who has guided him through the previous visions. In verse 7, Jesus speaks. What is Jesus promising?

4- Read Revelation 22:8-9 & Revelation 19:9-10. What lesson did John learn in these passages? What can we learn from these passages today?

5- Read Revelation 22:10-11 & Ezekiel 20:39. How do these passages shed light on each other?

6- Read Revelation 22:12-13. What truth are these verses emphasizing? What are some ways that these words could have encouraged the 1st century Christians who were persecuted by the Roman Empire?

7- Read Revelation 22:12-13 again. How do Christ's words bring comfort to your life today?

8- Read Revelation 22:14-15 & Revelation 7:14. What did the washing of robes symbolize? What are these verses saying? Why do we need reminded of our sins being forgiven?

9- Read Revelation 22:16-17. Notice the different voices (and directions) that are shouting "Come!". How do you picture these verses in your mind?

10- Read Revelation 22:18-19. These verses provide a warning with an opportunity to remember previous visions & Bible stories. What is the warning? What Bible stories and/or visions from Revelation pop in your mind as you read these verses?

11- Read Revelation 22:20-21. After all of the visions that John saw, He proclaimed his desperate desire to be with Jesus. "Come, Lord Jesus!", he shouted. John didn't ask Jesus to give him anything or do anything for him...except to come. How does John's plea inspire or challenge you?

12- What do you need to carry away from our journey through the book of Revelation?

13- Spend some time praying for one another. Use the answers to the previous question (#12) to guide you.
