Group Discussion Guide

1- On Sunday, we began our journey through the book of Acts. What do you remember most from the message?

2- Does everyone have access to our daily reading plan? For those who did not receive a bookmark...the reading plan is also available on our website <http://www.sccky.org> Brainstorm some ways that your group members can discuss our daily readings.

3- Read Acts 1:1-11 together. Which verse(s) pop out at you the most?

4- Read Acts 1:1-2 & Luke 1:1-4 together. What are some ways that these passages relate to each other?

5- Read Acts 1:3, Genesis 7:11-12 (Flood story), Exodus 24:17-18 (Moses on the mountain receiving 10 commandments), Numbers 13:25 (12 spies in the Promised Land) & 1 Samuel 17:16 (Goliath taunting Israelites). What pattern do you see with the “40 days” & God’s people?

6- Read Acts 1:4-5, John 14:16-17, John 15:26 & John 16:7-15. How do these passages relate with one another? What do these passages teach us about our relationship with the Holy Spirit?

7- When is the last time that you felt like God had placed you in a season of waiting on Him?

8- Read Acts 1:6-7 & Ezekiel 37:21-27. What details do you notice the most in either passage? How does Ezekiel help us understand how the apostles’ question more?

9- Read Acts 1:8 together. What is your initial thought or feeling when you read this verse?

10- Read Acts 1:9-11 together. What are some ways that we can resemble the apostles gazing into the clouds? What can we learn from the two men dressed in white?

11- As we close out our discussion on Acts 1:1-11, we have the apostles waiting for the Holy Spirit to come into their lives. Although Christ's disciples now have the indwelling presence of the Holy Spirit, we still find ourselves waiting on the Lord. What are some ways that you are waiting today? How can our small group support one another in our waiting?

12- Spend some time lifting one another up in prayer.
